	<ul> <li>Pastor (poimen) - Latin for 'shepherd'.</li> <li>Elder (presbuteros) - a seasoned leader.</li> <li>Bishop (episkopos) - an overseer; supervisor.</li> <li>Shepherd (poimen) - one who takes care of others.</li> <li>Overseer (episkopos) - a Bishop.</li> <li>1 Peter 5:1-5</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Know the people (v.18).</li> <li>Serve the Lord by serving His people (v.19).</li> <li>Have compassion and tenderness of heart (v.19).</li> <li>Be evangelistic (vv.20-21).</li> <li>Be willing to suffer for the cause of Christ (v.22-23).</li> <li>Be selfless (v.24).</li> <li>Know God's plan and timing (v.25).</li> <li>Be faithful (vv.26-27).</li> <li>Give encouragement (v.28).</li> <li>Warn the church of false preachers and teachers (v.29).</li> <li>Purify and cleanse the fellowship (v.30).</li> <li>Be alert to Satan's methods and ministers (v.31).</li> <li>Equip the saints for ministry, then let them minister (v.32).</li> <li>Serve with no thought of reward (vv.33-34).</li> <li>Be charitable (v.35).</li> </ul>
